Land: The land should be free of encumbrances and the respective state government should construct the boundary wall and should hand over to avoid the further problems. 2. As far as possible the forest land should not be allocated, as diversion of forest area land takes considerable time and institution activities suffer a lot. 3. The allocated land should not have any litigation/court cases etc. 4. There should be some task force from the respective state government to resolve the issues, if any, during construction, etc.
