### **About the School:**

With a commendable contribution from IIT Kharagpur's noted alumnus (1967) Mr.Vinod Gupta, Founder-chairman of InfoUSA, the school was established with a mission to develop outstanding management professionals capable of playing leadership roles in their chosen careers in organisations in different sectors of the economy, especially in technology-driven and knowledge based industries that are characterized by high degrees of globalisation, dynamism, complexity and innovativeness. The main focus of the Centre is on advanced post graduate and doctoral programme in Business Management, Management Development and other areas.

# **Important Highlights**

### About VGSoM

Vinod Gupta School of Management (VGSoM), founded in 1993, is the first and the largest business school to be set-up within the IIT system. With a generous contribution from one of its illustrious alumni, Mr. Vinod Gupta, VGSoM envisions producing management leaders by offering unique programmes blending both management and technology. Over the years VGSoM has been able to establish itself as one of the most reputed management institutes of the country.

The School has highly qualified faculty members in the areas of Financial Management and Accounting, Economics, Production and Operations Management, Marketing Management, Management Information Systems, Human Resource Management, Business Communication, Strategic Management and Technology Management. ### **Programmes Offered Through VGSoM**

### Master of Business Administration (MBA) Programme

Master of Business Administration (MBA), the flagship programme of the Institute is a full time four semester (2 year) residential programme for graduate engineers and Masters' degree holders in science, economics and commerce, intending to pursue management careers in India or abroad.

The high quality, two-year, full-time residential MBA programme offered by this business school strikes an innovative balance between theory and practice of management. The MBA curriculum has evolved to among the best in the country combining the traditional strengths of IIT in technical education with modern management philosophy. Teaching techniques include a judicious mix of lectures, case-studies, group projects and workshops. A two-month summer internship in industry exposes students to practical management problems.

The core of the programme includes compulsory courses in Human Resource Management, Production & Operations, Marketing, Finance, Information Systems Management, Organizational Behavior, Economics, Strategic Management, Legal Aspects of Business, Business Ethics, Quantitative Methods and Business Communication. A large number of electives from several departments of IIT are available for students who wish to pursue their individual interests in greater depth. In addition, students are encouraged to participate in and assist with all peripheral administrative functions in the school as this helps inculcate a sense of team spirit in them.

### **Executive Master of Business Administration (EMBA) Programme**

With the ever increasing pace of knowledge creation and obsolescence of knowledge, professionals can no longer presume to be a high achievers over their entire career banking only upon their initial professional qualifications. For working professionals, to achieve the fullest career potential there is a growing need for MBA Programmes that are recognized worldwide. The EMBA programme of VGSoM aims to provide a vehicle for growth to executives by augmenting their skill sets and knowledge and reorienting their attitude. The programme ensures a firm foundation for continued learning towards making oneself relevant to the market needs.

The programme is offered on Saturdays and Sundays over a span of three years. The three year duration includes eight ten week terms (over the course of two years) of teaching, and three ten week terms (over the course of one academic year) of live projects and case development within the organization that the students are employed in.

# Ph.D Programme

The School offers an advanced programme in management leading to the award of the Ph.D. degree through IIT Kharagpur. The programme requires candidates to go through a package of compulsory courses recommended by the Doctoral Scrutiny Committee and write a Dissertation. The students currently enrolled in the doctoral programme are engaged in research in the areas of Marketing, Operations, Finance, Strategic Management and Human Resources.

### **Short Term Courses, Conferences and Industry Liaison**

The School offers short duration programmes for practising managers in various functional areas. The purpose of such programmes is to provide an opportunity to executives to update their knowledge in their fields of expertise and also to help them acquire the knowledge, skills and attitude required to function in other areas where they may not have had any previous exposure. Management Development Programmes (MDPs) are offered at Kharagpur and in other cities in India. Specially customized programmes are also offered in house and on campus upon request from specific organizations. Faculty members gain valuable experience through teaching in such MDPs, which is then used to enhance the quality of teaching in the MBA Programme.

### **Current Achievements of the School**

In addition to excelling in their fields, VGSoM students have routinely brought laurels to the Institute in the form of outstanding, award-winning performance in various national and international academic and extracurricular competitions held across the country. The Finance group at VGSoM spearheaded the Financial Engineering programme at IIT Kharagpur. VGSoM is now one of the few business schools in the country and in the South Asian sub-continent to have access to Bloomberg Professional, a database offering "real-time data, news and analytics" about corporate organizations world-wide. The school also recently revived the VGSoM Working Paper Series, an initiative to encourage management researchers and scholars to share their work with their peers, and to seek feedback from senior professionals for their works in progress.
