# Minutes of the meeting held on Statutory compliance of Contractual requirements on 22-6-2015 at Board Room of Simrol Campus

Dean of Administration convened an urgent meeting on 22-6-2015 to draw the attention of all concerned on the need for statutory compliance of all the contractual requirements with a thrust on labour laws in IIT Indore. The following members participated in the meeting.

The following points were discussed:-

Dr. Pritee Sharma, Dean of Administration drew the attention of the members present to the need for fulfilling all the statutory compliances especially relating to labour laws in the wake of certain serious developments in one of our sister Institution.

During the course of deliberations the followings points were brought out and compliance of these needs to be ensured. :

1. It was assured that where the Institute is directly employing manpower, the compliances are verified and open for verification at any point of time which are foolproof.

2. Whereas, the need for ensuring compliances in respect of indirect engagement of manpower where the Institute had engaged contractors on work accomplishment basis especially in Project Construction / works, was reiterated.

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The following measures were suggested and agreed upon for reporting back within a period of fortnight by the Project Team:

- 2.1 Verification of validity of Labour Licence possessed by the contactors i.e Simplex, Premco and United Engineers;
- 2.2. Compliance of Safety and security, Health issues of the labourer to be verified with concerned records;
- 2.3. Payment of minimum wages by the contractor to all the labourers engaged as per Minimum Wages Act 1948;
- 2.4. Verification of Timely payment of wages to the labourers engaged with the help of proper records;
- 2.5. Ensuring of deposition of <u>statutory deductions of Labour welfare such as EPF and ESI</u> contributions as per respective acts by the contractor.
- 2.6. Salary payment be made in the presence of the representatives of the Project Management Consultant (PMC) twice in a month which shall be duly authenticated and a random checking will also be made by the Institute representatives periodically not below the level of Executive Engineer. PMC shall also do random check of muster roles on regular intervals
- 2.7. Grievance redress mechanism shall be put in place for receiving and redressing the complaints of the labourers through
  - a. Installing complaint box in which aggrieved persons can drop his/her complaint(s).
  - b. A compliance certificate from the Contractor along with each bill may be asked for before releasing the payment to them.
- 3. It was suggested that the following further measures could be considered to plug non-compliance of any labour laws in IIT Indore:-
- 3.1. Appointment of <u>Labour Welfare Officer by the contractor</u> to look into issue of labourers engaged in site in relation to construction activity is required. <u>The concerned officer may monitor the progress of compliance of labour laws and regular reporting to estate section is to be done.</u>

Project Works: Superintending Engineer relating compliance of labour laws:-

- 1. It has been ensured that where the Institute is directly employing manpower, all the compliances are taken care of and is open for verification at any point of time which are foolproof.
- 2. In respect of indirect engagement of manpower where the Institute had engaged contractors based on work accomplishment especially in Project Construction / works, a periodic routine inspection system through the Project Management Consultant is put in place and is also subject to random checking by the authorised representatives of the Institute.

# Measures were also taken for verification of the following aspects by the Project Team:

- 2.1 Verification of validity of Labour Licence possessed by the contactors i.e Simplex, Premco and United Engineers;
- 2.2. Compliance of Safety and security, Health issues of the labourer to be verified with concerned records;
- 2.3. Payment of minimum wages by the contractor to all the labourers engaged as per Minimum Wages Act 1948;
- 2.4. Verification of Timely payment of wages to the labourers engaged with the help of proper records;
- 2.5. Ensuring of deposition of <u>statutory deductions of Labour welfare such as EPF and ESI</u> contributions as per respective acts by the contractor.
- 2.6. Salary payment be made in the presence of the representatives of the Project Management Consultant (PMC) twice in a month which shall be duly authenticated and a random checking will also be made by the Institute representatives periodically not below the level of Executive Engineer. PMC shall also do random check of muster roles on regular intervals
- 2.7. Grievance redressal mechanism is put in place for receiving and redressing the complaints of the labourers through
  - a. Complaint box in which aggrieved persons can drop his/her complaint(s).
  - b. A compliance certificate from the Contractor along with each bill may be asked for before releasing the payment to them.

- 3. Further measures to be considered to plug any loopholes in compliance of any labour laws in IIT Indore:-
- 3.1. Appointment of <u>Labour Welfare Officer by the contractor</u> to look into issue of labourers engaged in site in relation to construction activity is required. <u>The concerned officer may monitor the progress of compliance of labour laws and regular reporting to estate section is to be done.</u>
- 3.2 Display of the notices about the Grievance redressal mechanism with contact details for information of the workers.
