These are very low operational energy systems which are put in fluoride contaminated areas in Rajasthan and especially in rural government primary and secondary schools. 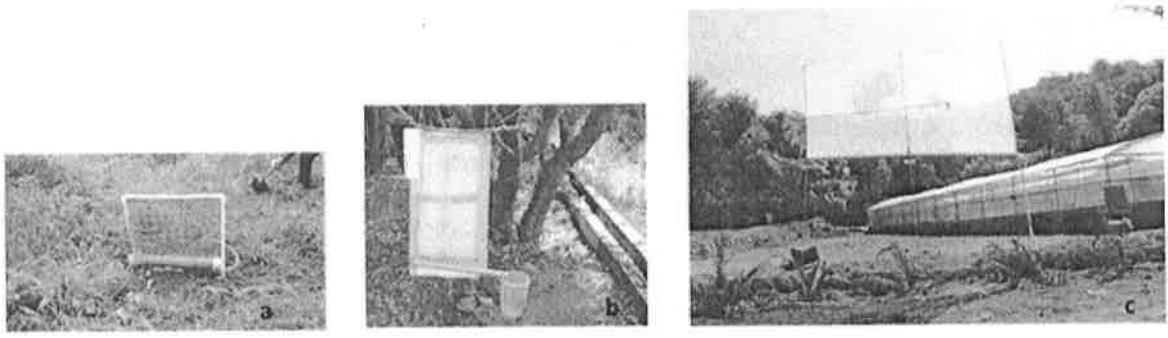

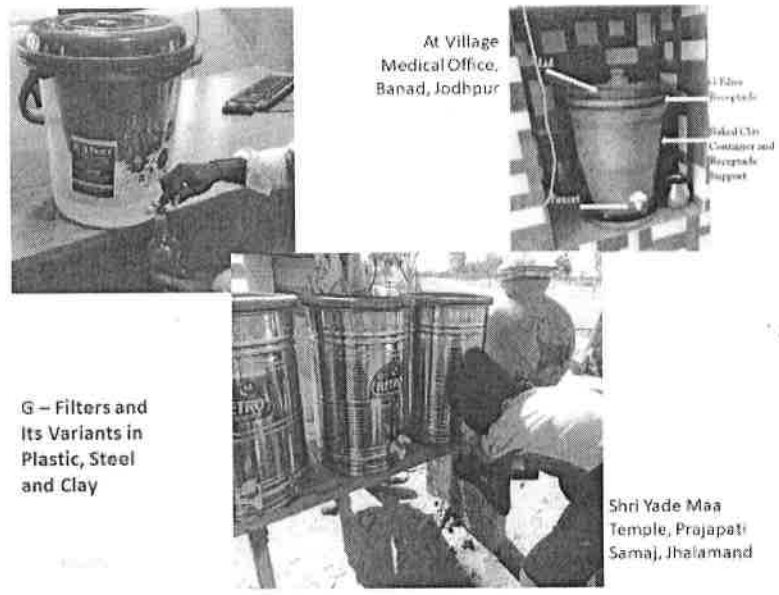

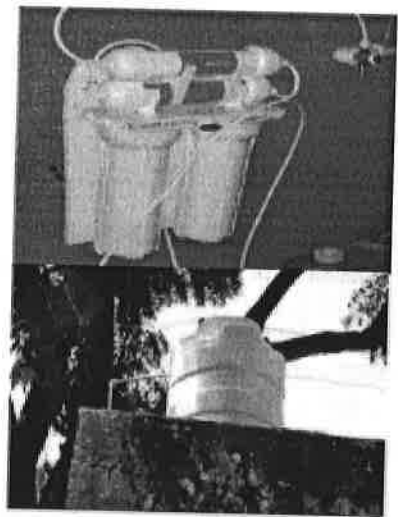

The progress made at IIT Jodhpur on water management and conservation technology is given below:

1. **Ultra-Filtration Based Technologies** have been put down on the field by IIT Jodhpur in rural primary schools in villages across districts, namely Pali, Jhunjhunu, Jodhpur, and Sirohi. These are very low operational energy systems which are put in fluoride contaminated areas in Rajasthan and especially in rural government primary and secondary schools. 2. **Sub-surface Porous Vessels for Irrigation** The SSPV technology is a sub-surface irrigation which can help water conservation in areas of high solar irradiation and physical water stress. Till date IIT Jodhpur has worked in Pali, Jodhpur and Sirohi districts.

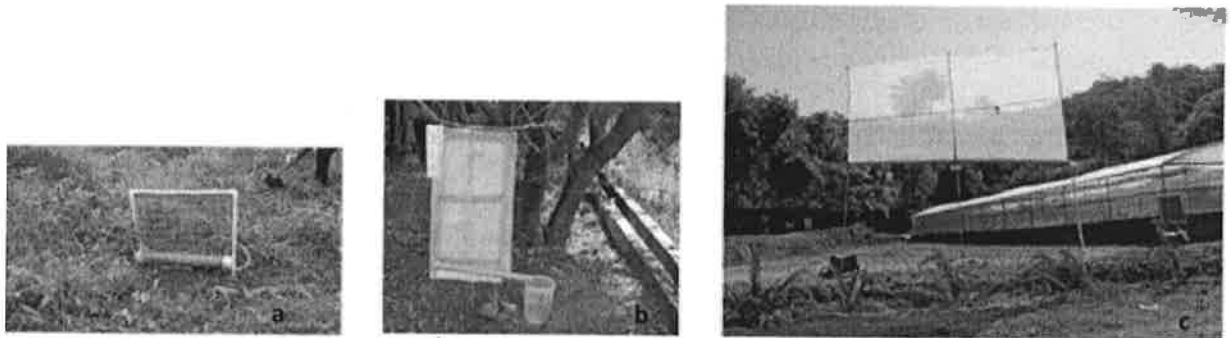

The technology is beneficial to deal with flooding, skill sustenance in pottery, water harvesting, and soil restoration. This technology was developed using funds from the IIT Delhi RuTAG office.

3. **Water Harvesting:** IITJ is performing water harvesting activity since 2011, by have harvest tanks which can used collect of rain water. These tanks were are located under each of the student hostels at IIT Jodhpur.
4. **Dew Catching at Mt. Abu, Sirohi** Local commercially available nets are used and modified to enable it to catch variation. They work only in the peak winter seasons. Here water production is the main objective and may vary from location to location.



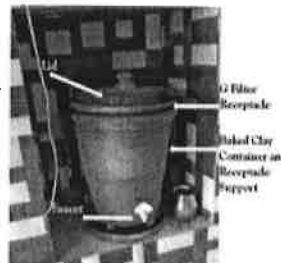


