Reply: The institute has been active in reversing the brain drain by adopting following measures:

- Making available state of the art facilities to carry out front-line research to attract (i) graduates to engage on doctoral studies in IIT Indore.
- By attracting Indian researchers working abroad to apply for faculty positions at (ii) IIT Indore. Through the help of Indian missions abroad, bright researchers working in USA and Europe have been identified for one to one detailed meetings and discussions to showcase advantages of working in IIT Indore. Advantage of this is that many Indians who had not considered returning to India, as a result of meeting Director and other senior colleagues and learning of IIT Indore, get convinced to apply and be considered for positions at IIT Indore.
- Making use of the Young Investigators Meeting (YIM) held annually In the U.S. to meet and discuss with Indians working in the US and to showcase advantages of returning to India.

I invite a reference to your e-mail on the above mentioned subject and to furnish the information in respect of IIT Indore:

- (a) Whether only 66 per cent of IITians have got job opportunities during 2016-17 as compared to 79 per cent in 2015-16 and 78 per cent in 2014-15.
- **Reply:** The placement percentage at IIT Indore in 2016-17 was 84.33% which was a bit drop as compared to last 2 years. However, in terms of average packages & median, it was better than 2015-16 & 2014-15 placement sessions.
  - (b) Whether the above reflects stagnation or economic downturn;

Reply: In our opinion, above reflects both factors.

- (c) To what extent the protectionist steps taken by US, UK, Australia, New Zealand, Saudi Arabia and other countries impacted prospects on Indian IITians and others; and
- **Reply:** Yes, the protectionist steps taken by these countries have impacted prospects of Indian IITians to some extent.
  - (d) If so, how the Ministry is planning to address this issue?

Reply: We should focus more on improvising the quality and number of:

- (i) Domestic & local Job opportunities
- (ii) Job opportunities in PSUs
- (iii) To encourage & provide support to viable startups (by IITians)
