Additionally, entry into the Institute in an intoxicated condition is prohibited. The Institute's premises have been declared a no-tobacco zone, and awareness posters have been placed across various locations on campus. IIT Goa maintains a stringent stance on these policies and imposes fines and penalties on those found violating them.</p>

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23	IIT Dharwad	<p>The various initiatives and activities undertaken by IIT dhArwAD for addressing the pressing issues of drug abuse, emphasizing the detrimental effects of intoxication, and promoting de-addiction are as under:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1) Policy Implementation: Established and enforced policies at the institute level prohibiting drug, alcohol, and tobacco use on campus. Fines and penalties are imposed on students violating the campus code of conduct.2) Counselling services: The Institute provides counselling services for students struggling with substance abuse issues offering support and guidance through the online platform "YourDost" which is available 24*7 and also an in-house counselor available for consultation in the Wellness Centre.3) Supportive Environment: The Institute has created a Students Mentorship Program that encourages students to seek help if they are struggling with drug abuse and related issues through trained student mentors and faculties.4) Education and Awareness: A large number of IIT Dharwad students participated in Drug Awareness Walkathon on 25th June 2023 organised by the District Police Department, Dharwad. An institute-level pledge-taking program by all the students in this regard was conducted in July 2023.
