Ans.: Women's Cell IITB submits an annual report to MHRD detailing all complaints received and action taken. In the year 2017, six complaints were received:

- 1. Of these, in two cases, Internal Complaint Committee (ICC) recommended appropriate punishment.
- 2. One case was referred to Dean (SA), to be taken up by the Disciplinary Action Committee.
- 3. Another was referred to the Registrar since it was not a case of sexual harassment, but involved misbehaviour by a staff member and the employee has been warned appropriately.
- 4. In the fifth case, the complainant did not register an official complaint. The issue was settled by mutual reconciliation.
- (c) whether University Grants Commission (UGC) has reviewed such existing arrangements and taken appropriate measures for the safety and security of the girls and women in higher education including Universities?
