Response from IIT Guwahati

Reference: Question No.78 for answer on 4th February, 2019 asked by Shri Muthamsetti Srinivasa Rao, regarding "IIT Students" has been admitted in the Lok Sabha as unstarred.

The text of the question is as under:

(a) whether the Government has suspended Indian Institute of Technology(IIT) first year students for not performing well in the exams;

Responses: The UG students who have secured CPI less than 4.0 out 10 in two consecutive semesters shall be liable to be terminated from academic programme at IIT Guwahati. Such students need to submit reinstatement appeal to the Senate before the date of registration for the next semester. Considering the merits in the appeals, the Senate/ institute reinstate and allow them to continue in the academic programme. At IIT Guwahati, at the end of first year, the UG students normally reinstated and allowed to continue in the academic programme by extending academic help to them through Peer Assisted Learning, Special Faculty / Student Mentor, etc in the subsequent semesters. The undergraduate students are normally given multiple chances to continue in the programme and to improve their academic performances in the first three years.

(b) if so, the details and reasons therefor; and

Responses: Not Applicable.

(c) the remedial measures taken/being taken by the Government in this regard?

Responses: At IIT Guwahati, the following remedial measures are taken to help the UG students for improving their academic performance.

• Peer Assisted Learning:

i. Senior Undergraduate Students conduct discussion and helping sessions (Doubt Clarification and Problem Solving) for the first year core courses to the first year undergraduate (BTech, BDes) student who need additional help or exhibited poor performance in-class assessments in the Hostels after dinner time.

- ii. PhD Scholars conduct special tutorial sessions (1.5 hours to 2 hours) for the first year core courses to the to the first year undergraduate (BTech, BDes) student who need additional help or exhibited poor performance in-class assessments on Saturdays and Sundays.
- Special Faculty Mentor/ Student Mentor: Apart from the faculty advisor, special faculty mentor or a specific student Mentor is assigned by the Head of the Department to help the academically weaker students and continuously monitor their academic performance.
- <u>Summer Term Courses:</u> At IIT Guwahati, certain courses are exclusively offered during Summer Term to help the students who have failed during regular semester to do and pass the courses.
- Supplementary Examinations: At IIT Guwahati, supplementary examinations are conducted for the courses of BTech, BDes, MSc, MA Programmes to the students who failed in the courses (other than seminar and project based courses) due to poor academic performances in the immediately preceding semester.

For teaching employees:

Though IIT Guwahati does not specifically ask for reserved posts, applications from candidates from reserved categories are encouraged and due weightage is given at the shortlisting stage

The 2nd Meeting of the reconstituted Standing Committee of IIT Council (SCIC) held on 11/2/2008 recommended reservation for SCs, STs and OBCs in direct recruitment of Faculty. The matter was put up in the 53rd, 54th and 58th Meetings of the Board held on 22/5/2008, 5/9/2008 and 6/9/2009, respectively The Board agreed with the decision of the Directors of all the IITs to seek exemption for IITs from reservations for faculty recruitment. However, the Board approved the following methodology for implementing reservations for all departments of the Institute, in case exemption is not agreed to after the appeal is made by all the IITs.

In beginning of every academic year (July), the Institute will announce the number of positions to be filled up at the Assistant Professor level across all departments in the institute in the year. This number will depend on the number of total vacancies (based on a student: faculty ratio, as specified from time to time) and the needs of positions at various levels.

Reservations of 15%, 7½% and 27% reservation for SCs, STs and OBCs, respectively shall be applied to the positions so announced and selection committees shall interview candidates as per current norms and make appointments against the positions, keeping in mind the reservations, and the appointments already made through earlier selection committees in the year.

At the end of the year, all reserved positions that are not filled will be "de-reserved" and be available for filling up in the general category in the next year. For the next year, besides these positions that are "de-reserved", new positions will be declared.

For non-teaching employees:

The recruitment process for various posts is going on and Institute hopes that it will be able to fill up all backlog reserved vacancies after completion of the of recruitment process.
