- As per the guidelines of GoI, IIT Bhubaneswar provides reservation of seats in various courses offered by the Institute, as is statutorily required, for the students under ST communities.
- Financial and other assistance and waiver in Tuition fees, as applicable, are also provided to the students of ST communities, while pursuing various academic programmes under this Institute.
- In order to help the needy students of these community to come up to a desired level of academic excellence, frequent inter-active classes, as also counseling session, are conducted by the Institute.
- The IITs are providing one year preparatory course for ST candidates who have not qualified to be allotted seats for the current year to improve the intake of ST students in the B.Tech and Dual Degree programmes of IITs. The Preparatory Courses is a one year residential programmes and prepares the students to be eligible for the B.Tech or Dual Degree Courses at the IITs.
